OFF-CAMPUS PROGRAMMES

The **Honorable Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu** established the Tamil Nadu Music and Fine Arts University exclusively for Music, Fine Arts and Performing Arts so as to preserve, foster, popularize and promote the music, fine arts and performing Arts.

The **Honorable Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu is the Founder and the First Chancellor of this University.** The Honorable Minister of School Education who is in charge of portfolio of Culture in the State of Tamil Nadu **Thiru. K.C. Veeramani is the Pro-Chancellor of this University.**

Kalaimamani Tmt. Veena E. Gayathri, the first and present Vice-Chancellor of this University has the vision for the all young development and nurturing of the Music and Fine Arts and Performing Arts through academic, research and extension programme in Tamil Nadu and taken in to greater heights globally.

As per the Tamil Nadu Government Act No.30 of 2013 Chapter II / The University/3(I) (ii), the Tamil Nadu Music and Fine Arts University, Chennai has to establish Off-Campus Programmes in Tamil Nadu for the development of Skill based Music, Fine Arts and Performing Arts in Tamil Nadu.

VISION:

To widen the academic horizons in the field of Music, Fine Arts and Performing Arts through Off-Campus mode for the development of the people in all sections of the society.

MISSION:

To conduct skill oriented Diploma and Certificate Courses in the field of Music, Fine Arts and Performing Arts through Off-Campus mode with assuring the quality by the way of proper in build mechanism.

OFF-CAMPUS PROGRAMME:

1. Certificate and Diploma Courses will be offered in the field of Music, Fine Arts and Performing Arts and other related subjects to fulfill the Vision and Mission of the University.
2. The Duration of the Course are :-
 - i. Diploma Courses – One year (Non Semester Pattern).
 - ii. Certificate Courses – Six months.
3. Eligibility Criteria :-
 - i. Diploma Courses – 8th Pass.
 - ii. Certificate Courses – 5th Pass.

The eligibility depends upon the nature of the course. It will be decided by the University based on recommendation of the respective Board of Studies.
4. Age :-

There is no upper age limit for the candidates seeking admissions in Diploma and Certificate courses.
5. Admission :-

The courses will be offered in Academic Session and Calendar year Session.
6. Period of Study :-

- i. The candidates will be permitted to write their Examinations and to complete their Diploma Courses within three years from the date of admission of the Course.
- ii. The candidates will be permitted to write their Examinations and to complete their Certificate Courses within two years from the date of admission of the Course.

8. The University will invite experienced Trust/Society/institution in the field of Music, Fine Arts and Performing Arts to offer the Certificate and Diploma Courses in Off-Campus Centres through Tamil Nadu Music and Fine Arts University. The Off-Campus Centres shall offer the Courses only after Approval and due Recognition by the University.

9. The student intake per batch will be fixed on Recommendations of Inspection Commission based on the infrastructural facilities available in the Off-campus Centre. The Vice-Chancellor be authorized to fix/alter the intake/Revision of intake/Additional Section etc., and the same be reported to the Syndicate.
10. The interested and eligible Trust / Society / Institutions/Colleges shall apply in the prescribed format. The filled-in application along with Processing and Inspection fee of Rs.20,000/- sent to the University by means of Demand Draft drawn in favour of “The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Music and Fine Arts University” payable at Chennai.
11. The Off-Campus Centre should have the following facilities :-
 - i. Proper infrastructure facilities
 - ii. Adequate space and classrooms
 - iii. Basic amenities and rest room
 - iv. Qualified faculties
 - v. Lab/Play Rooms/ Performing stages
 - vi. Sufficient Equipments/Instruments/Machineries
 - vii. Library Books
 - viii. Computers with Connectivity
12. The Centres will have to pay Refundable Caution Deposit and Non-Refundable Registration Fee to the University towards starting of Certificate/ Diploma Courses in those Centres.

13. The application form and prospectus shall be prepared and issued by the University.
14. The cost of application is Rs.300/- for Diploma and Rs.100/- for Certificate Courses will be remitted to the University.
15. The Off-Campus Centre should make necessary arrangements for at least two local advertisements in their jurisdiction at their own cost with the prior approval of the University.
16. The Off-Campus Centres will be permitted to start in Taluk Headquarters/and other places Permission will be given by the University based on the need and demand in Chennai and other Corporation / Municipal Cities.
17. The Off-Campus Centre will collect the University fee from the students only a Demand Draft drawn in favour of “The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Music and Fine Arts University” payable at Chennai and remitted to the University at the time of admission.
18. The Off-Campus Center to share the Tuition Fees as follows:

The Off-Campus Centre to remit the University share amount along with other fees prescribed by the University at the time of admission.

The amount sharing shall vary depending upon the uniqueness / innovative/specialized courses being offered by the centre.

19. The Off-Campus Centre shall not collect any other amount over and above or any mode from the Students apart from the fees prescribed by the University.
20. The Off-Campus Centre is responsible to conduct the Theory and Practical Classes as per University Norms..
21. The University Examination will be conducted by the Controller of Examinations in the approved common exam centers during the month of June and December in every year.
22. The fees for examinations will be fixed by the University time to time.
23. The Vice-chancellor be authorized to inspect the Off-Campus Centre at any time and give suggestion for the improvement of the Off-Campus Programme.
